

Transfer to Medical Studies at the Sahlgrenska Academy

If you have studied pharmacy at a non-Nordic Faculty, you are entitled to apply for studies from semester 2 at the University of Gothenburg. Acceptance will depend on the number of places available. Ranking takes place via random allocation if the students have equal requirements.

1/ General and special requirements

In order to apply, you must be the holder of certificates showing that you have passed all courses in the subjects that are included in the Programme in Medicine in Gothenburg during the semester previous to the one you are applying for.

You must have completed a foreign upper secondary education that provides you with the required qualifications to carry out university studies. Such education should be equivalent to academic upper secondary school in Sweden.

You must have studied subjects such as mathematics, physics, chemistry and biology on the same level as a Swedish upper secondary school. An evaluation of your educational certificates can be carried out by the National Admissions Office to Higher Education. Please contact:

2/ Language

Your knowledge of English should be equivalent to no less than 550 credits on the TOEFL-scale.

The undergraduate programme in Medicine at Göteborg University is conducted in Swedish.

If you already know Swedish you must prove that your knowledge in Swedish is sufficient by passing the *Swedish Language Test for University Studies, TISUS*, which is arranged during the spring every year in Sweden and abroad at the Swedish Embassy and at some Swedish international schools. You can also choose to provide other certificates of your education in Swedish proving that you have sufficient knowledge of the Swedish language, written and oral.

3/ Previous knowledge

Certificates from upper secondary school supporting general and special requirements as well as certificates supporting completed medical training courses should be sent together with your application. The certificates should be translated into Swedish or English by an authorized translator. Applications should be submitted not later than the 15th of October respective the 15th of April to the address in the letter.
